IN THE COURT OF INDUSTRIAL APPEALS.

In the MATTER of the FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACTS and in the MATTER of the DETERMINATION dated the 1st day of October, 1909, of the SPECIAL BOARD appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room, in the process, trade, or business of a maker of ice for trade or sale, or of a person carrying on the business of freezing, refrigerating, packing, or grading goods of any kind for the purpose of trade or sale in a frozen or refrigerated condition other than ice cream.

THIS APPEAL, coming on for hearing before this Court on the 16th, 17th, 20th, 21st, and 29th days of December instant: Upon reading the Notice of Appeal herein dated the 12th day of November last, and upon hearing what was alleged in support of and in opposition to the said Appeal, this Court doth order and determine that the said Appeal be and the same is hereby allowed and that the Determination of the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room in the process, trade, or business of a maker of ice for trade or sale, or of a person carrying on the business of freezing or refrigerating, packing, or grading goods of any kind for the purpose of trade or sale in a frozen or refrigerated condition other than ice cream, dated the 1st day of October, 1909, be amended by fixing the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to Chamber Hands (*i.e.*, persons employed in delivering, receiving, bagging, stacking, or putting meat, rabbits, butter, and other goods in a freezing chamber, and also those employed in chipping snow from pipes) at 1s. an hour in lieu of 1s. 3d. an hour. This Determination to come into force on Saturday, the 1st day of January, 1910.
