WONTHAGGI CONSTITUTED A BOROUGH.

*At an Executive Council held at Wonthaggi, the twenty-sixth day of January, 1911.*

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the *Wonthaggi Borough Act* 1910 (1 Geo. V. No. 2300), His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order sever from the Municipal District of the Shire of Phillip Island and Woolamai so much thereof as is described in the First Schedule to the said Act; and doth constitute the same a Borough under the Local Government Acts under the name of the Borough of Wonthaggi; and doth alter the boundaries of the Municipal District of the said Shire so as to correspond with those set forth in the Second Schedule to the said Act No. 2300; and doth determine that the Council of the said Borough shall consist of nine members, and that the said Municipal District thereof shall be unsubdivided.

And the Honorable William Lawrence Baillieu, His Majesty's Commissioner for Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
