Health Act 1890.

SHIRE OF MELTON,-BY-LAW No. 23.

IN pursuance of the powers contained in the *Health Act* 1890, and of any other powers thereunto enabling them in that behalf, the Council of the Shire of Melton, in the name and on behalf of the President, Councillors, and Ratepayers of the said Shire, for the purpose of carrying the said Act into execution within their jurisdiction, make the following By-law, that is to say: sav :-

- 1. That all the provisions of By-law No. 22 of this Shire for the regulating of closets and privies, and the emptying and cleansing of pans, shall apply to and have operation in the following areas:—
 - (a) That part of the township of Melton that is bounded by the Toolern Creek proceeding westerly along Henry-street to the south-west angle of allotment 2, section 33; thence northerly along street unnamed to the north-west angle of allotment 1, section 30; thence easterly along street unnamed across a blind creek or gully continuing easterly along Collyer-street to the north-eastern angle of allotment 2, section 15; thence southerly by Walton-street to the commencing point, Toolern Creek, all in the parish of Djerriwarth.
 - Creek, all in the parish of Djerriwarrh.

 (b) Commencing at the north-west angle of Crown allotment A, section 4, parish of Djerriwarrh; thence south forty chains along the west boundary of the said allotment; thence in a line due east to the Toolern Toolern Creek; thence northerly along that creek to a point due east of the north boundary of allotment Dr5; thence west to the north-east angle of that allotment; thence west along the north boundary of allotments Dr5, D14, and D13 to the north-west angle of the last-named allotment; thence north-westerly noross a road to the south-east angle of lot D2; thence west along the south boundary of lots D2 and D6 to the south-west angle thereof thence south along a road to the commencing point.

2. All former By-laws, so far as they relate to the things provided for in the By-law and are inconsistent therewith, are hereby repealed.

The foregoing By-law was duly made, ordered, and passed by the Council of the Shire of Melton this 31st day of July, One thousand nine hundred and eleven, and confirmed this 20th day of September, One thousand nine hundred and eleven. hundred and eleven.
