Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE ICE BOARD.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room in the process, trade, or business of a maker of ice for trade or sale, or of a person carrying on the business of freezing, refrigerating, packing, or grading goods of any kind for the purpose of trade or sale in a frozen or refrigerated condition, other than ice cream, has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 22nd day of January, 1912.

TIMES OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK.

5. That the times of beginning and ending work for all persons, other than foremen, and ice pullers and stackers, shall be—

OVERTIME.

6. That any employé who, within the hours of beginning and ending work, works in any week for any time in excess of 48 hours, shall be paid for such extra time at the wages rate of time and a quarter.

That any person, other than foremen and ice pullers and stackers, who is engaged outside the hours specified in clause 5 of this Determination as the times of beginning and ending work upon each day, shall be paid for such overtime at the wages rate of time and a quarter.

SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

7. That the special price or rate of payment payable for work done on Sundays and the undermentioned public holidays shall be as follows:—
