SHIRE OF DANDENONG.

BY-LAW NO 30.

IN pursuance of all or any of the powers conferred by the Public Health Act 1890 and by the Local Government Act 1903, the President, Councillors, and Ratepayers of the Shire of Dandenong order as follows:

I. This By-law and the unrepealed portions of By-law No. 18 shall apply to and have operation in the following portions of the Shire of Dandenong, known as the Carrum district, or part of that district: Commencing at the northwest corner of Crown allotment 12A, parish of Lyndhurst; thence along the Mordialioc Creek to the intersection of the drain running along the east boundaries of Crown allotments 135 to 101 in the said parish; thence to the south-east corner of Crown allotment 115; thence westerly by the Eel-race-road to the Frankston-road; thence to the south-westerly by the southern boundary of that allotment and a straight line to Port Phillip Bay; thence along Port Phillip Bay to the point of commencement. along Port Phillip Bay to the point of commencement.

2. In addition to the provisions contained in By-law No. 20 as to the removal of pans in use, every occupier and every person having the management and control of any house or premises within the aforesaid area, or portions of the said Shire, when thereunto required by the Council of such Shire, or its officer authorized generally or specially for such purpose, shall, at his or her own cost and expense, so much more frequently than once a week as the said Council or officer may from time to time direct, cause the pan in use on such house and premises to be closed with a close fitting lid, and removed with its contents from the premises in the day time, and the other pan to be left in its place, and the night-soil removed and rendered inoffensive, and the provisions of this clause shall be deemed to be in addition to provisions for the once-a-week service contained in clause 6 of the By-law No. 18, and the cost and expense of the work and services provided for by or the subject of this By-law shall not be deemed to be covered by any annual charge made by the said Council under the said By-laws Nos. 18 and 20.

3. Every such occupier or person as mentioned in the

3. Every such occupier or person as mentioned in the last preceding clause shall, before leaving any pan as provided in such clause in a closet or privy, at his or her own cost and expense, cause the same to be cleansed by superheated steam and tar-painted inside, or by some equally efficient means.

4. Every person who shall by any wilful act or default be guilty of any breach of this By-law shall be liable to a penalty, at the discretion of the Court or Justices, either of Five pounds for every such breach or Two pounds for each day during which such breach shall be committed or continued, unless the Justices before whom the penalty is sought to be recovered shall order any portion only of either of the said penalties, such portion being not less than Five shillings, to be paid, and any

person committing any such breach as aforesaid shall be liable to the penalty notwithstanding that the Council may be empowered by this By-law or otherwise to remedy such. breach and whether such Council has or has not taken advantage of such powers.

Resolution of passing this By-law agreed to by the Council on the sixth day of November, 1911, and confirmed the eleventh day of December, 1911.
