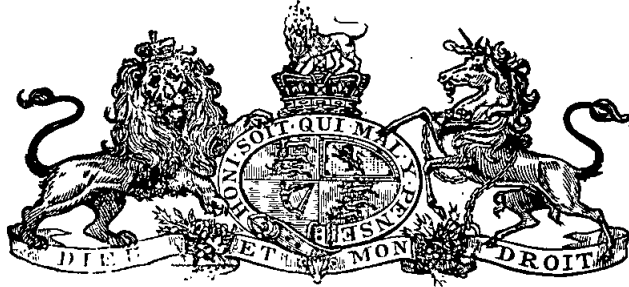

By His Excellency Sir John Michael Fleetwood Fuller, Baronet, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the seventh day of May, 1912: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the fourth day of June, 1912.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this thirtieth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twelve, and in the second year of His Majesty's reign.
