publication: And whereas a petition signed by more than one-fourth of the ratepayers whose names appear on the municipal roll of the City of Essendon has been presented to the Governor in Council, notice of which petition was published in the *Government Gazette* of the 24th April, 1912, and no counter petition has been received: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby re-subdivide the said City into four (4) separate Wards, to be named the Essendon Ward, Moonee Ponds Ward, Ascot Vale Ward, Aberfeldie Ward, the several boundaries of which are hereunder set forth and described, viz:—

ESSENDON CITY.—RE-SUBDIVISION OF WARDS.  
*Essendon Ward.*

Commencing at a point on the north-east boundary of the city where Woodland-street meets the Moonee Ponds Creek; thence southerly by that creek to Buckley-street; thence westerly by that street to the western boundary of the city; thence northerly and easterly by that boundary to the commencing point.

*Moonee Ponds Ward.*

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the city where Buckley-street meets the Moonee Ponds Creek; thence southerly by that creek to Ormond-road; thence westerly by that road to the Mount Alexander-road; thence south-easterly by the latter road to the Maribyrnong-road; thence westerly by that road to the North-Eastern railway line; thence north-westerly by that railway line to Buckley-street; thence easterly by that street to the commencing point.

*Ascot Vale Ward.*

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the city where Ormond-road meets the Moonee Ponds Creek; thence following the city boundary southerly, westerly, and northerly to the Maribyrnong-road; thence easterly to the Mount Alexander-road; thence north-westerly by that road to Ormond-road; thence easterly by that road to the point of commencement.

*Aberfeldie Ward.*

Commencing at a point where Buckley-street is intersected by the North-Eastern railway line; thence south-easterly by that railway line to Maribyrnong-road; thence westerly by that road to the western boundary of the city; thence following the city boundary northerly to Buckley-street; thence easterly by that street to the commencing point.

The city boundary above referred to is that described in the *Government Gazette* of the 17th November, 1882.

WHEREAS by the *Local Government Act 1903* (3 Edw. VII. No. 1893) it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may, without any petition, make Orders altering, for the purpose of adjustment, the boundaries of conterminous municipal districts or subdivisions: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, for the purpose of adjusting the conterminous boundaries of the Shires of Eltham and Healesville, doth hereby declare the boundaries herein set forth and described to be in lieu of those previously proclaimed, which are hereby cancelled, that is to say:—

SHIRES OF HEALESVILLE AND ELTHAM.—ADJUSTMENT OF  
BOUNDARIES.

*Healesville Shire.*

Commencing at the junction of the Watts and Yarra Yarra Rivers; thence southerly and easterly by the latter river to the road between allotments 12 and 11, section B, parish of Gracedale; thence northerly by that road and the western boundary of allotment 54 to the north-west angle of said allotment; thence easterly to the north-east angle of same; thence northerly by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 50c; thence easterly by that allotment to its north-east angle; thence southerly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 57; thence by the southern and eastern boundaries of said allotment to the north-west angle of allotment 4, section C; thence easterly by part of that allotment to the south-west angle of allotment 5; thence northerly by that allotment and allotment 6B to the north-west angle of the allotment last named; thence westerly by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 7A; thence northerly by that allotment and allotment 7C to the north-east angle of the last-named allotment; thence easterly by part of allotment 44B to the south-east angle of that allotment; thence northerly by the east boundary of the last-named allotment to Badger's Creek; thence easterly by that creek to the west boundary of block 49, parish of Yuonga; thence north by that block to the north-west angle thereof; thence north-easterly about thirteen miles twenty chains on a direct line towards Mount Arnold; thence south-easterly by a direct line about fifteen miles forty chains to the junction of the mining track from McMahon's Creek with the Wood's Point-road; thence north ten chains; thence in a north-westerly direction by a line ten chains north of the Dividing Range to the 146th meridian of east longitude; thence north by that meridian to the north boundary of pastoral allotment P1; thence west by that boundary and a line in continuation thereof to the Great Dividing Range; thence northerly by the summit of that range to Mount Arnold; thence north-westerly by a direct line to the south-east angle of allotment 26, parish of Taggerty; thence westerly, north-westerly, and south-westerly by a road and the south-east boundary of allotment 2 to the Acheron River; thence northerly by that river and a road to the south-east angle of block 26B, parish of Glendale; thence west by the south boundaries of blocks 26B, 26A, and 14A to the south-west angle of the block last named; thence north by the west boundaries of block 14A and part of 5 to the south-east angle of block 73; thence west by the south boundaries of blocks 73 and 72 to the south-west angle of the block last named; thence by a direct line southerly to the north-west angle of block 69, parish of Granton; thence south by the west boundaries of blocks 69, 75, 78, 83A, and 83B to the south-west angle of the latter block; thence south-westerly by a direct line to the summit of Mount St. Leonard; thence southerly by the Great Dividing Range to the summit of Mount Monda; thence north-westerly by the Great Dividing Range following the road to the north-west corner of allotment 69c, parish of Tarrawarra North; thence southerly along the west boundary of that allotment, the State Forest, and allotments 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, and 85 to the south-west corner of the allotment last named; thence easterly along the south boundary of that allotment to the north-east corner of allotment 50B, parish of Tarrawarra; thence south by a road to the north-west corner of allotment 44; thence easterly along the northern boundary of that allotment to its north-east corner; thence southerly along the eastern boundaries of the said allotment and allotment 34 to the south-west corner of allotment 33; thence south-easterly by that allotment to the north-east corner of allotment 28A; thence southerly by the eastern boundary

of that allotment to its south-east corner; thence south-westerly and south-easterly by a road between allotments 10 and 12 to the River Yarra; thence easterly by that river to the commencing point.

*Eltham Shire.*

Commencing at the junction of the Yarra Yarra and Plenty Rivers; thence northerly by the latter river to the north boundary of section 3, parish of Nillumbik; thence east by that boundary and the north boundary of section 4 to the Diamond Creek; thence northerly by that creek to the north-west angle of allotment B, section 16; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 6, section 17; thence north by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 5 (Larimour); thence west by the north boundary of that allotment to Diamond Creek aforesaid; thence northerly by that creek and Arthur's Creek to the south boundary of allotment 71, parish of Kinglake; thence west by that boundary and north by the west boundaries of allotments 71, 72, and 73A to the summit of the Great Dividing Range; thence easterly by the road on the top of that range to the road forming the south boundary of allotment 20B and block 56; thence east by that road to the south-east angle of the last-mentioned block; thence southerly by a road to the road forming the north boundary of allotment 29; thence east by that road to the Island Creek; thence northerly by that creek to the south boundary of block 51; thence easterly by that block to the south-east angle thereof; thence southerly by a road to a point opposite the east boundary of Robert Carter's block; thence south by a line, the east boundary of the last-mentioned block, and the east boundary of allotment 43 to the road forming the north boundary of allotments 44 and 45; thence east by that road to the north-east angle of the last-mentioned allotment; thence south by the east boundary of that allotment and a line to the summit of the Great Dividing Range aforesaid; thence easterly by that range following the road to the north-west corner of allotment 69c, parish of Tarrawarra North; thence southerly along the west boundary of that allotment, the State Forest, and allotments 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, and 85 to the south-west corner of the allotment last named; thence easterly by the south boundary of that allotment to the north-east corner of allotment 50B, parish of Tarrawarra; thence south by a road to the north-west corner of allotment 44; thence easterly along the northern boundary of that allotment to its north-east corner; thence southerly along the eastern boundaries of the said allotment and allotment 34 to the south-west corner of allotment 33; thence south-easterly by that allotment to the north-east corner of allotment 28A; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of that allotment to its south-east corner; thence south-westerly and south-easterly by a road between allotments 10 and 12 to the River Yarra; thence south-westerly by that river to the commencing point.

ridings, to be named the Morwell Riding, Yinnar Riding, Hazelwood Riding, Boolarra Riding, the several boundaries of which are herein set forth and described, that is to say:—

**MORWELL SHIRE SUBDIVIDED.**

*Morwell Riding.*

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the shire at the south-west corner of allotment 26, parish of Narracan; thence easterly along the southern boundary of that parish to the Morwell River; thence northerly by that river to the southern boundary of the parish of Maryvale; thence easterly by the southern boundary of that parish to the south-west corner of allotment 11; thence northerly by a road to the Melbourne and Sale railway line; thence north-easterly by the said railway line to the shire boundary; thence northerly and south-westerly by the shire boundary to the point of commencement.

*Hazelwood Riding.*

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the shire at the south-west corner of allotment 26, parish of Narracan; thence easterly by the southern boundary of that parish to the Morwell River; thence southerly by that river to Billy's Creek; thence south-easterly by that creek to the south-west corner of allotment 12, parish of Jeeralang; thence easterly by the southern boundary of that allotment to the north-west corner of allotment 12F; thence southerly by the western boundary of said allotment and allotment 12E to the south-west corner of the last-named allotment; thence easterly along the southern boundary of said allotment 12E to the shire boundary; thence south-easterly and south-westerly by the said boundary to the south-east corner of the Agricultural College reserve; thence north-westerly by Whitelaw's Track to the southern boundary of the parish of Yinnar; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that parish to the Morwell and Mirboo road at the east corner of allotment 23B1; thence north-westerly by the eastern boundary of the said allotment to its north-east angle; thence westerly by a road to the Mirboo and Morwell railway line; thence south-westerly by the said railway line to a point opposite the south-east corner of allotment 20; thence west by a road along the south boundary of that allotment to the Morwell River; thence southerly and northerly by that river to the south-east corner of allotment 126, parish of Narracan South; thence westerly along the southern boundary of said allotment to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence southerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 87A; thence westerly along the southern boundary of said allotment to its south-west corner; thence westerly by a road along the southern boundaries of allotments 82, 108, and 108A to the north-west corner of allotment 110B; thence southerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 57; thence southerly by a road along the south boundaries of allotments 110A and 56A to the south-west corner of the last-named allotment; thence north-westerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 35A; thence by a road along the southern boundary of said allotment and allotment 34 to the south-west corner of the allotment last named; thence northerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 33; thence westerly by a road to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence northerly by a road to the shire boundary; thence westerly, southerly, south-easterly, and northerly by the shire boundary to the commencing point.

*Boolarra Riding.*

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the shire at the south-east corner of the Agricultural College reserve; thence north-westerly by Whitelaw's Track to the southern boundary of the parish of Yinnar; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that parish to the Morwell and Mirboo road at the east corner of allotment 23B1; thence north-westerly by the eastern boundary of the said allotment to its north-east angle; thence westerly by a road to the Morwell and Mirboo railway line; thence south-westerly by the said railway line to a point opposite the south-east corner of allotment 20; thence west by a

road along the south boundary of that allotment to the Morwell River; thence southerly and northerly by that river to the south-east corner of allotment 126, parish of Narracan South; thence westerly along the southern boundary of said allotment to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence southerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 87A; thence westerly along the southern boundary of said allotment to its south-west corner; thence westerly by a road along the southern boundaries of allotments 82, 108, and 108A to the north-west corner of allotment 110B; thence southerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 57; thence south by a road along the south boundaries of allotments 110A and 56A to the south-west corner of the last-named allotment; thence north-westerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 35A; thence by a road along the southern boundary of said allotment and allotment 34 to the south-west corner of the allotment last named; thence northerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 33; thence westerly by a road to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence northerly by a road to the shire boundary; thence westerly, southerly, south-easterly, and northerly by the shire boundary to the commencing point.

**PHILLIP ISLAND AND WOOLAMAI SHIRE RE-SUBDIVIDED.**  
*Bass Valley Riding.*

north by the west boundary of that allotment to the south-east corner of allotment 150; thence west along the south boundary of that allotment to its south-west corner; thence north by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 153; thence west by the south boundary of that allotment to its south-west corner; thence north by the west boundary of that allotment and a road to the north-east corner of allotment 158; thence west along the north boundary of that allotment to the Bass River; thence southerly by that river to the south-east angle of allotment 216C; thence west along the south boundary of that allotment and allotment 216 to the south-east corner of allotment 214; thence west by a road along a portion of the south boundary of that allotment to a three-chain road; thence north-westerly by that road to the north-east corner of allotment 199A; thence west by the north boundary and south by the west boundary of that allotment to the south-east corner of allotment 198A; thence west by a road to the south-west corner of allotment 198; thence north by a road to Western Port Bay; thence by the shire boundary northerly, easterly, and southerly to the commencing point.

*Powlett Riding.*

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the shire at the south-east corner of allotment 50, parish of Wonthaggi North; thence west along the south boundary of that allotment and a road to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence south by the east boundary of allotment 46 to its south-east corner; thence west along the south boundaries of that allotment and allotment 47 to the south-west angle of allotment last named; thence northerly by a road to the north-east corner of allotment 61; thence west along the north boundary of that allotment to its north-west corner; thence southerly by a road to the south-east corner of allotment 59; thence west along the south boundary of that allotment and allotment 88 to the south-west corner of allotment last named; thence northerly by a road along the eastern boundary of allotments 83 and 87 to the northern angle of the last-named allotment; thence south-westerly by a road to the south boundary of allotment 91; thence west along the south boundary of that allotment to its south-west corner; thence west along the north and south along part of the west boundary of allotment 19 of the Agricultural College Reserve to the north-east corner of allotment 16; thence west along the north boundary of that allotment and south-westerly by a road along the western boundary of said allotment to the most southern corner of allotment 4; thence westerly along the southern boundaries of that allotment and allotments 2 and 1 to the south-west corner of allotment last named; thence south by a road along the west boundaries of allotments 5, 6, and 7 to the north-east corner of allotment 99B; thence west by the north and south by the west boundary of that allotment to the south-east corner of allotment 99A; thence west by a road to the north-west corner of allotment 95A; thence south by a road along the west boundaries of that allotment and allotments 95B and 94B to the south-west corner of the last-named allotment; thence east by a road along the south boundary of said allotment 94B to Bridge Creek; thence southerly by that creek to the Powlett River; thence southerly by that river to the shire boundary; thence in a south-easterly, easterly, and northerly direction by the said shire boundary to the commencing point.

*Woolamai Riding.*

Commencing at a point on the south boundary of the shire at the mouth of the Powlett River, parish of Woolamai; thence northerly by that river to its junction with Bridge Creek; thence northerly by that creek to a road on the south boundary of allotment 94B; thence west by that road to the south-west corner of said allotment; thence north by a road along the west boundaries of allotments 94B, 95B, and 96A to the north-west corner of allotment last named; thence east by a road to the south-west corner of allotment 90B; thence north by the west and east by the north boundary of that allotment to the south-west corner of allotment 7 of the Agricultural College Reserve, parish of Wonthaggi North; thence north by a road along the west boundaries of that allotment and allotments 6 and 5 to the south-west corner of allotment 1; thence east by the south boundaries of that allotment and allotments 2 and 4 to the most southern corner of the last-named allotment; thence north-easterly by a road to the south-west corner of allotment 17; thence east by the south boundary of that allotment to its south-east corner; thence north by the west and east by the north boundaries of allotment 19 to the north-east corner of said allotment; thence north along the west boundaries of allotments 91 and 92, parish of Wonthaggi North, to the north-west corner of the allotment last named; thence west along the north boundary of allotment 18 of the Agricultural College Reserve, to the east boundary of allotment 146, parish of Corinella; thence north along the east and west along the north boundary of that allotment to the south-east corner of allotment 144; thence north along the east and west along the north boundary of that allotment to the south-west corner of allotment 144; thence north by the west boundary of that
