### SHIRE OF RODNEY.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO BORROW THE SUM OF £3,000 (THREE THOUSAND POUNDS) FOR PERMANENT WORKS AND UNDERTAKINGS.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Shire of Rodney proposes to borrow the under-mentioned sum, upon the credit of the President, Councillors, and Ratepayers of the Shire of Rodney, by the issue of debentures for such amount, in accordance with the provisions of the *Local Government Act 1903*. And notice is further given that—

- (a) the amount of the principal moneys which it is proposed to borrow is Three thousand pounds;
- (b) the rate of interest to be paid is Five pounds per centum per annum;
- (c) the moneys borrowed are to be repayable by sixty equal half-yearly instalments, including principal and interest, of Ninety-seven pounds one shilling and threepence, on the first day of March and the first day of September in each respective year; and all such moneys shall be payable at the Bank of Victoria Limited, Tatura;
- (d) the loan is to be expended in the construction, establishment, and installation of an electric light and power plant and service within the area of supply for the township of Mooroopna;

- (f) the plans, specifications, and estimates of the cost of such works and undertaking, and a statement showing the proposed expenditure of the money to be borrowed, are open for inspection at the office of the Council, at the Shire Hall, Tatura.
