FIXING PRICES OF WHEAT UNDER PRICE OF
GOODS ACT 1914.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the
second day of November, 1914.

WHEREAS the Prices Board appointed under the
Price of Goods Act 1914 with respect to the
price now fixed by Proclamation as the highest selling
price for wheat, namely, Four shillings and ninepence
per bushel *ex railway siding* Melbourne or Geelong,
has, under date the 27th day of October now last past,
now reported that where wheat is held in producing
districts at places other than Melbourne or Geelong, the
highest selling prices at such places should be Four
shillings and ninepence per bushel less the cost of car-
riage to Melbourne or Geelong from such places respec-
tively, but where wheat has been bought in Melbourne or
elsewhere and consigned to places in the country that the
highest selling prices for such wheat in such places
should be Four shillings and ninepence per bushel plus
the cost of carriage to such places respectively: Now
therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of
Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth
of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive
Council of the said State, doth by this present Order
declare that the prices specified in the report of the
said Board for wheat shall, for the purposes of the
Price of Goods Act 1914, be the highest selling prices
for the same (that is to say):—

The highest selling price for wheat shall be Four
shillings and ninepence per bushel *ex railway*
siding Melbourne or Geelong; where wheat is
held in producing districts at places other than
Melbourne or Geelong the highest selling prices
at such places shall be Four shillings and nine-
pence per bushel less the cost of carriage to
Melbourne or Geelong from such places respec-
tively, but where wheat has been bought in
Melbourne or elsewhere and consigned to places
in the country the highest selling prices for
such wheat in such places shall be Four shillings
and ninepence per bushel plus the cost of car-
riage to such places respectively.

And the Honorable Sir Alexander James Peacock,
His Majesty's Treasurer for the State of Victoria, shall
give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
