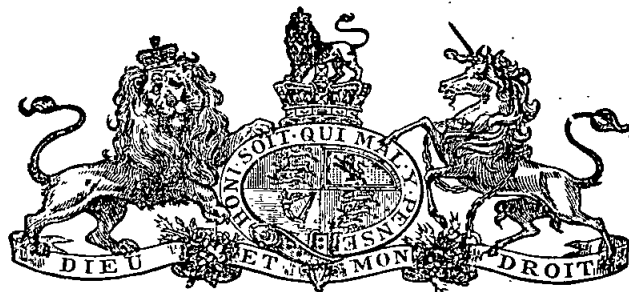

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict.
