WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the ninth day of March, 1915: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the thirteenth day of April, 1915.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this third day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and in the fifth year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
