Factories and Shops Acts.

EXEMPTION FROM SATURDAY HALF-HOLIDAY AND REGULATION OF CERTAIN SHOPS WITHIN A RADIUS OF HALF-A-MILE OF THE COCKATOO RAILWAY STATION AND THE GEMBROOK RAILWAY STATION.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-fourth day of July, 1917.

UNDER the powers in that behalf conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, upon petitions signed in each case by a majority of all the shopkeepers (exclusive of hawkers and pedlers) keeping shops within the portions of the municipal district of the Shire of Berwick, within a radius of half-a-mile of the Cockatoo Railway Station and within a radius of half-a-mile of the Gembrook Railway Station respectively, of the particular classes to be affected, doth hereby make the following Regulations, that is to say:

(1) All sbops (except shops for the sale of fresh

- (1) All shops (except shops for the sale of fresh uncooked meat, hairdressers' shops, and shops of the classes or kinds mentioned in the Fourth Schedule to the Factories and Shops Act 1915) within the portions of the municipal district of of the shire of Berwick, within a radius of half-a-mile of—
- (a) the Cockatoo Railway Station, and
  (b) the Gembrook Railway Station,
  shall be exempted from the provisions of
  section 77 of the Factories and Shops Act
  1915.

  (2) All such shops shall be closed in each week
  during the whole of each year from the hour
  of—
  - (a) Ten o'clock on the evening of Saturday;
    (b) Six o'clock on the evening of Friday;
    (c) One o'clock on the afternoon of Wednesday.

And the Honorable Sir Alexander James Peacock, His Majesty's Minister of Labour for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
