Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE STOREMEN PACKERS AND SORTERS BOARD.

Note.—(a) The Storemen Packers and Sorters Board, when first constituted, had power to tix rates for any person employed as storemen packer or sorter in connexion with the trade or business of—
making biguite.

making biscuits; manufacturing or preparing for sam milk, cream, butter, or cheese;

making nails;

preserving most, or preparing food products from animal fat;

preserving most, or preparing food products from animal fat;

making paper, cardboard, carpet felt, or any similar products.

Those powers were taken away, by Orders in Council, dated 21st June, 1913, 19th August, 1913, 11th November, 1913, and 4th July, 1916, respectively.

(b) This Determination on the 11th June, 1917, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, the Cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, and Geelong, the Towns of Ballarat East and Warrnambool, and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geolong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

(5) Special Rates for Sundays and Public Holidays.—Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Day, or Eight Hours Day (21st April); and time and a half shall be the rate for all work done on Easter Monday, Foundation Day (26th January), King's Birthday (3rd June), or Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the days so substituted.

(6) Casual Labour.—Casual hands, i.e., persons who are employed during any week for not more than one-half the maximum number of hours fixed in this Determination as a week's work shall be paid:—

## PIECE-WORK.

(7) The Board determines under the provisions of sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 144 of the Factories and Shops Act 1915, No. 2550, that any employer may fix and pay piece work prices for wholly or partly packing or sorting any articles for which wages rates are fixed, provided that such employer shall base such piece-work prices on the earnings of an average worker working under like conditions, and such piece-work prices shall be fixed so that an average worker can earn not less than the wages rate fixed by the Board for such work.
