Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE DRAPERS BOARD. -

Nors.—This Determination on the 16th September, 1918, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the Cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the Town of Ballarat East; and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wherescever employed in the business of a seller of goods usually sold by drapers or haberdashers (other than boots of any kind and articles of male attire), including mantles, costumes, millinery, gloves, stockings, and underclothing, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 16th day of September, 1918, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

⁽⁴⁾ CASVAL LABOUR.—Casual employees (i.e., persons employed during any week for not more than 24 hours) shall be paid at the rate of time and a half.

⁽⁵⁾ Special Rates.—Time and a half shall be the special rate for all work done on New Year's Day, Foundation Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), King's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
