Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE WOODWORKERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 14th day of October, 1918, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the Cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the Town of Ballarat East; and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed as—

(a) Carpenters, joiners, or box-makers;
(b) Stackers, sorters, loaders, or unloaders of sawn timber;
(c) Sεw-mill, timber yard, box factory, or joiner's workshop employees,

but not including persons under the jurisdiction of the Carpenters, Agricultural Implements, or Picture Frame Boards or persons engaged in shipbuilding or the erection of bridges, wharfs, or similar structures, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 14th day of October, 1918, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked, and replaced by this Determination.
