## DETERMINATION OF THE PLASTERERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 12th November, 1918, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the Cities of Ballarst, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the Town of Ballarst East; and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices of rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons (other than labourers) wheresoever employed in the process, trade, or business of a plasterer, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 12th November, 1918, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
