Factories and Shops Acts.

### DETERMINATION OF THE CORDAGE BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 15th day of March, 1918, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, the Cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, and Geeleng, the Towns of Ballarat East and Warrnambool, and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a maker of rope. twine, cordage, halters, coir mats, or coir matting has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 15th March, 1918, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
