## DETERMINATION OF THE MANUFACTURING CHEMISTS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 7th August, 1919, applied to the following parts of Victoria, viz.:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of—

(a) a wholesale or a manufacturing chemist:
 (b) manufacturing toilet preparations, perfumery, essences, essential oils, food preservatives, branding fluids, deodorants, disinfectants, fungicides, insecticides, vermin destroyers, weed destroyers,

has made the following Determination, namely:-

(1) That this Determination shall be operative on and after the 7th August, 1919.

<sup>(3)</sup> OVERTIME.—Any employee who in any week works for any time in excess of the maximum number of hours fixed for a week's work shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a half.

<sup>(4)</sup> Special Rates.—All work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, 26th January (Foundation Day), Easter Monday, Good Friday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), 3rd June (King's Birthday), Christmas Day and Boxing Day, shall be paid for at the rate of double time, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above holidays, the special rates shall be payable only for the days so substituted.
