CONSOLIDATED INFLUENZA AMENDING REGULATIONS AMENDMENT.

UNDER the powers conferred by the Health Acts and under all other powers me enabling in that behalf, I, the undersigned, the Honorable John Bowser, His Majesty's Minister of Health for the State of Victoria, do make the Regulation following:—

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Consolidated Influenza Amending Regulation 1919 (No. 2).
2. Paragraph 5 of the Consolidated Influenza Amending Regulations 1919 (No. 1) is hereby repealed.
