(SETTLEMENT OF DISCHARGED SOLDIERS).



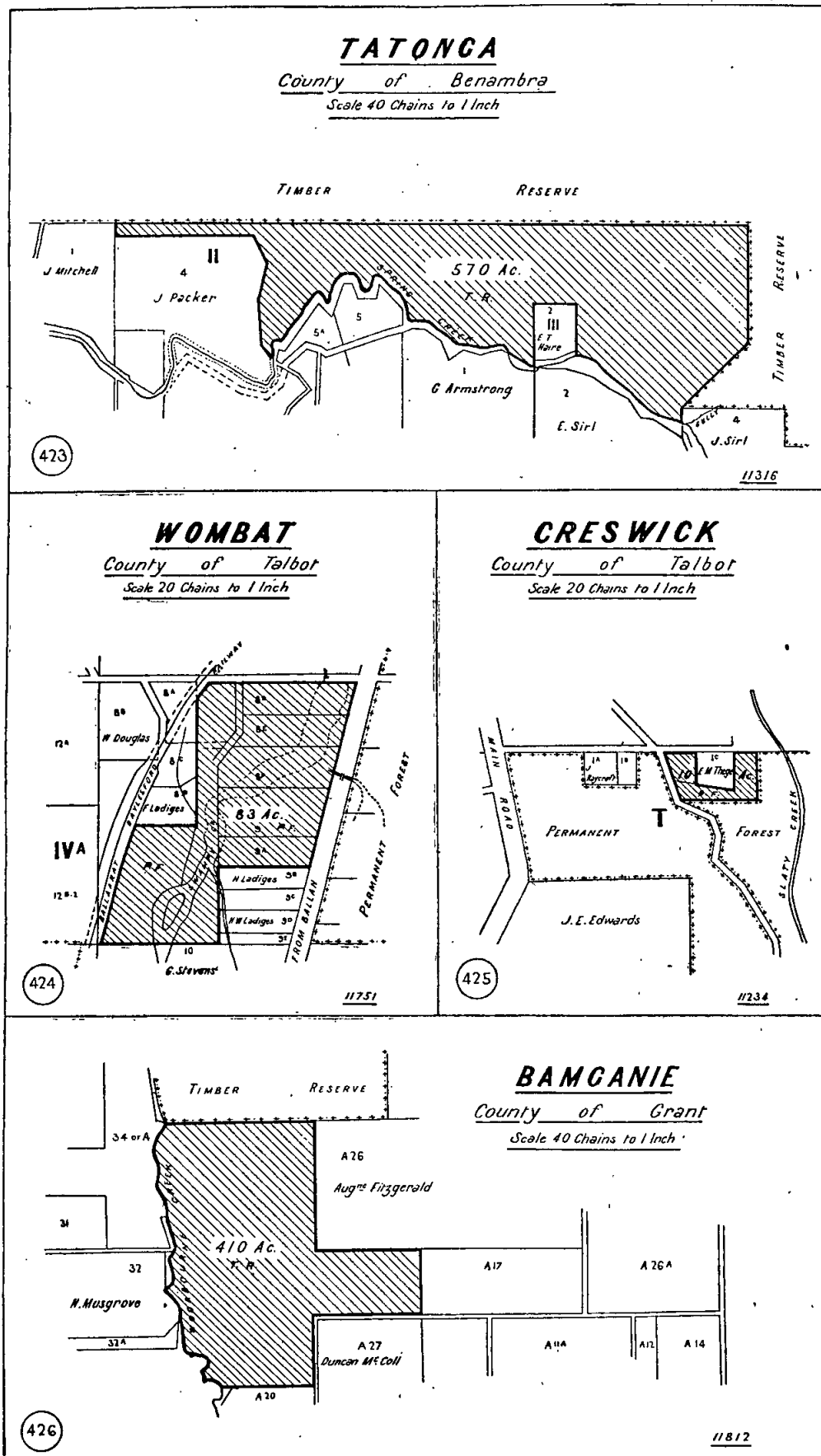
