Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 26th June, 1919, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wheresoever employed in any business or occupation connected with the installation of electrical fittings, appliances, motors, and heaters, including the laying of wires, has made the following Determination, namely:

(1) That on the 26th June, 1919, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this-Determination

* (5) SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—All work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), King's Birthday (3rd June), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day shall be paid for at the rate of double time; but if any other day be substituted by Act of Parliament or Proclamation for the above, the special rate shall be payable only for the day so substituted.
