Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE STONE CUTTERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 5th July, 1920, applied to the Metropolitan District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol; and such portion of the East Riding of the shire of Werribee as is within 10 miles of a city or town.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of cutting, carving, polishing, and letter cutting in marble and stone," has made the following Determination, namely:—
