- (4) TIME OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK on each day Time of beginning. Time of ending.
... .. 6 a.m. 9 p.m.
- (5) OVERTIME—
- (a) Outside the hours fixed as the times of beginning and ending work { During the first 48 hours of such work in any week 1½d. per hour extra.
Thereafter Time and a half.
- (b) Within the hours fixed as the times of beginning and ending work in excess of 48 hours in any week. Time and a half.

(6) SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—That double time shall be the special rate for all work (except making fermented doughs) done on Sundays before 7 p.m., and that time and a half shall be the special rate for all work done on New Year's Day, 26th January (Foundation Day), 21st April (Eight Hours Day), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-mentioned holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
