Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PASTRYCOOKS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination, on the 21st June, 1920, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a pastry-cook" has made the following Determination, namely:—

Juvenile Workers.

(1) That on the 21st June, 1920, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

PROPORTIONATE NUMBER.

Apprentices.

One apprentice to every two or fraction of two workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

An indenture of apprenticeship prescribed was approved on 15th February, 1916.

Improvers.

One improver to the first three no improver to the first three workers receiving not less than 85s. per week of 48 hours, and thereafter one improver to every four additional such workers.
