Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 13th December, 1920, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Water Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or classes of persons wheresoever employed in any business or occupation connected with the installation of electrical fittings, appliances, motors, and heaters, including the laying of wires," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 13th December, 1920, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination. (2)

(4) OVERTIME.—The following rates shall be paid for all work done during the times specified hereunder:—

For each hour or fraction of an hour worked by any employee— Not more than four hours before or after his shift . .

More than four hours before or after his shift

.. Time and a half.
.. Double time.

(5) SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—All work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Foundation Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), King's Birthday (3rd June), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day shall be paid for at the rate of double time; but if any other day be substituted by Act of Parliament or Proclamation for the above, the special rate shall be payable only for the day so substituted.
