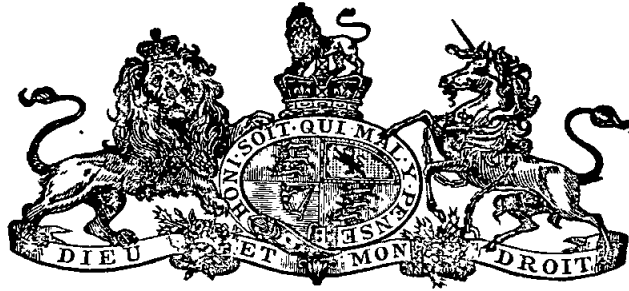

PRAHRAN ELECTION.—PETITION.

I HEREBY certify that there was presented to me on Thursday, the 9th day of December, 1920, a Petition, of which the enclosed is a true Copy.

To the Honorable John Emanuel Mackey, Esquire, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Victoria.

The humble Petition of WALTER GEORGE MINCHINTON, of 202 Commercial-road, Prahran, in the State of Victoria, Manufacturer,

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :

1. That a Writ was duly issued on the fifth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, to proceed to the election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly for the Electoral District of Prahran.

The said election was held on the twenty-first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and twenty.

2. That your Petitioner was a person who voted at such election.

3. That the Honorable Donald Mackinnon, of Acland-street, South Yarra, in the State of Victoria, barrister-at-law, and Alexander Frederick Parker, of Prentice-street, St. Kilda, in the said State, indent agent, were nominated as candidates at such election.

4. No other persons were nominated for or stood as candidates at such election.

5. That as a result of such election the Returning Officer announced that Alexander Frederick Parker aforesaid had received six thousand four hundred and eight votes, and the Honorable Donald Mackinnon, aforesaid, six thousand and forty-eight votes, and thereupon the Returning Officer declared the said Alexander Frederick Parker duly elected as a Member of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Victoria for the Electoral District of Prahran, and indorsed and returned the said Writ accordingly.

6. That the said Alexander Frederick Parker was not qualified to be a candidate at such election, inasmuch as he was at the time of his nomination not qualified to be elected a Member of the Legislative Assembly.

7. That the said Alexander Frederick Parker was not qualified to be elected as a Member of the Legislative Assembly inasmuch as he was at the date of his nomination, on the day of election, and at all other times material, subject to the disability created by section 134 of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1915* (No. 2632), that is to say :—

That the said Alexander Frederick Parker was on the dates aforesaid an uncertificated insolvent.

8. That your Petitioner claims that the said the Honorable Donald Mackinnon was the only qualified candidate at such election and was duly elected as Member of the Legislative Assembly at such election and should be declared duly elected, as such Member.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays :

That you will be pleased to communicate the matter of this Petition to the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in order that the same may be referred to the Committee of Elections and Qualifications of your Honorable House.

And also prays :

That it be declared that the said Alexander Frederick Parker was not a candidate at such election.

That the said Alexander Frederick Parker be declared incapable of being returned as a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly for the Electoral District of Prahran, and of sitting as such a Member.

That the election of the said Alexander Frederick Parker be declared void.

That it be declared that the said the Honorable Donald Mackinnon was returned as a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly for the Electoral District of Prahran, and that the return for such Electoral District be amended accordingly.

That it be declared that the said Alexander Frederick Parker is not now qualified as a Member for the said Electoral District.

And that your Petitioner may have such further and other relief as the circumstances of case may require or as to the said Committee of your Honorable House may seem meet.

And your Petitioner as in duty bound will every pray.

Dated this ninth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty.
