Factorics and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE UMBRELLA BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 8th May, 1920, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a maker of umbrellas" has made the following Determination

(1) That this Determination shall come into force and be operative on and after the 8th May, 1920.

(4) OVERTIME.—Any employee who, within the hours of beginning and ending work, works in any week for any time in excess of 44 hours, shall be paid for such extra time at the late of time and a half.

Any employee who is engaged outside the hours specified in this Determination as the times of beginning and ending work upon such day shall be paid for such overtime at the rate of time and a half.

(5) SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—All work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Foundation Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day shall be paid for at the rate of double time; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall be payable only for work done on the day so substituted.
