PRAYER OF CERTAIN PETITIONS REFUSED.

IS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in exercise of the discretionary power given by sections 16 and 35 of the Local Government Act 1915 (6 Geo. V. No. 2886), has this twenty-seventh day of May, 1921, after consideration, refused the prayer of the petitions under the provisions of the Act aforesaid as hereinafter mentioned, that is to say:—

Petition presented by certain ratepayers of a portion of the shire of Cranbourne (notice of which was duly published in the Government Gazette of the 16th March, 1921), praying that the area therein described be severed from the said shire and annexed to the shire of Frankston and Hastings.

Petition presented by certain ratepayers of a portion of the shire of Kerang (notice of which was duly published in the Government Gazette of the 6th April, 1921), praying that the area therein described be severed from the said shire, and constituted a new municipality under the name and title of the shire of Cohuna.

Petition presented by certain ratepayers of a portion of the shire of Werribee (notice of which was duly published in the Government Gazette of the 23rd March, 1921), praying that the area therein described be severed from the said shire and annexed to the city of Footscray.

RE-SUBDIVISION OF SHIRE OF FRANKSTON AND HASTINGS.

IS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, under provisions of the Local Government Act 1915 (No. 2686), sections 16 and 35, and acting on a petition signed by more than one-fourth of the ratepayers whose names are on the No. 107.-May 27, 1921 -8012.

Municipal Roll of the shire of Frankston and Hastings (notice of which was published in the Government Gazette of the 23rd of March, 1921), doth hereby re-subdivide the said shire into five (5) separate Ridings, to be named the—

Centre Riding, East Riding, Seaford Riding, Franksten Riding, and Mount Eliza Riding,

the several proposed boundaries of which are herein set forth and described, that is to say:—

RE-SUBDIVISION OF SHIRE OF FRANKSTON AND HASTINGS.

Frankston Riding.

Commencing at a point on the castern shore of Port Phillip Bay due west of the Mile Bridge over Kananook Creek, in the parish of Frankston; thence by a line due east to such bridge; thence northerly by the said creek to a point opposite the centre line of road being south boundary of allotments 53, 41, 40, 39, 38, 33A, 33B, a3B, and 33c to the eastern boundary of the shire; thence following the shire boundary southerly to the north-east angle of allotments 28B1; thence westerly by road along north boundary of allotments 28B1, 28A, and 27 to the north-west corner of the last-mentioned allotment; thence north-westerly by a road along the western boundaries of allotments 8A and 8b to the Flinders-Frankston road; thence north-westerly by that road to Foot-street; thence south by that street to William-street; thence west by that street to the shire boundary; thence northerly by the shire boundary to the commencing point. the commencing point.
