Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE LIMEBURNERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination, on the 3rd October, 1921, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of making lime," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That this Determination shall come into force and be operative on and after the 3rd October, 1921.

(3) OVERTIME.—Any employee who works for any time in excess of 44 hours in any week shall be paid for such extra time at the of time and a quarter for the first two hours, and thereafter time and a half.

A) SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—Time and a half shall be the special rate for all work done on Sundays, Christma b Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), Good Friday, or Easter Monday; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
