(4) OVERTIME.—All work done outside the hours specified as the times of beginning and ending work, or for any work done within such hours in excess of 48 hours in any week, shall be paid at the rate of time and a half.

(5) SPECIAL RATES-

Public Holidays.—Double time shall be the special rate payable to all persons for all work done on New Year's Day, Good for any of the above named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

Sundays.—Double time shall be the special rate payable to all persons (excepting gatekeepers) for all work done on Sunday.
