Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE PAINT AND COLOUR BOARD.

Note.—This Determination, on the 9th January, 1922, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of preparing any kind of paint, varnish, enamel, or colour, either wet or dry" has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That this Determination shall come into force and be operative on and after the 9th January, 1922.

<sup>(4)</sup> Special Rates.—Double time shall be the rate payable for all work done on Sunday, 26th January (Foundation Day), Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Easter Tuesday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), 3rd June (King's Birthday), Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and New Year's Day, but if any day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

<sup>(5)</sup> CASUAL LABOUR.—Any person employed for not more than 24 hours during any week shall be paid at the rate of time and a half.
