RE-DEFINITION OF THE AREA OR LOCALITY WITHIN WHICH THE DETERMINATION OF THE RESTAURANT BOARD SHALL BE OPERATIVE.

A BOOT REPAIRERS' BOARD TO BE APPOINTED.

(1) declare that it is expedient to appoint a Wages Board to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a boot repairer, and

(2) order that a Wages Board, consisting of six members and a Chairman, three of such Members being appointed as representatives of employers and three

as representatives of employees, be constituted and appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a Boot Repairer; also, that such Wages Board may in any regulation, determination, Order, or instrument, or legal proceedings, be described for all purposes as the Boot Repairers' Board, and the area or locality within which the Determination of such Wages Board shall be operative shall be the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, all cities and towns, and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

And the Honorable Sir A. J. Peacock, His Majesty's Minister of Labour for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
