Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PROCESS ENGRAVERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on 21st March, 1921, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham, and the boroughs of Eaglohawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a Process Engraver, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 21st March, 1921, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination
