By His Excellency Colonel the Right Honorable George Edward John Mowbray, Earl of Stradbroke, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Aide-de-Camp to His Majesty the King; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the eighteenth day of April, 1922 :
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the sixteenth day of May, 1922.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this tenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and in the twelfth year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
