Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE SAND PIT BOARD.

**NOTE.**—This Determination on the 16th May, 1924, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

**I**n accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in connexion with :—

A sand pit at labouring work, excavating sand, handling sand, or removing sand for trade or sale, but not including persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Carters Board," has made the following determination, namely :—

- (1) That this Determination shall come into force and be operative on and after the 16th May, 1924.

- (3) Time of beginning and ending work each day shall be :—

5 p.m.

- (4) OVERTIME.—The following rates shall be paid for all work done :—

- (a) Outside the hours fixed as times of beginning and ending work
- (b) Within the hours fixed as times of beginning and ending work in excess of 48 hours in any week

} Time and a quarter.

(5) SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.—Time and a half shall be the special rate for all work done on Sundays, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Years Day, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), Good Friday, or Easter Monday; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named public holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
