Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE FURNITURE (BEDDING) BOARD.

Nors.—This Determination on the 28th March, 1924, applied to the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geelong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to any person employed in the manufacture of mattresses or bedding" has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 28th March, 1924, the last previous Determination shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
