Motor Omnibus Act 1924 (No. 3378).

CONSENT TO THE MELBOURNE AND METROPOLITAN TRAMWAYS BOARD USING MOTOR OMNIBUSES TO PLY FOR HIRE ON ROUTE SPECIFIED HEREUNDER.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-eighth day of January, 1925.

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 16 (1) of the Motor Omnibus Act 1924 (No. 3378), doth by this Order consent to the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board using motor omnibuses to ply for hire within the metropolitan area along the route described in the Schedule horeunder, such consent being subject to the sections, stopping-places, time-tables, fares, and the maximum number of motor omnibuses to be used on such route as set out in the said Schedule being observed by the Board.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO ABOVE.

Description of Route, including Commencing and Terminal Points.

Commencing at the Melbourne Public Library, thence along Swanston-street, St. Kilda-road, High-street (St. Kilda), Brighton-road, and Glenhuntly-road, to the Elsternwick Railway Station.

Sections on Route.

The sections to be prescribed by subsequent Order in Council.

Stopping Places on Route.

Swanston-street .-- East side only-

At Public Library, north from Lonsdale street, south from Little Bourke-street, south from Little Collins-street, south from Little Flinders-street.

North from Little Flinders-street, north from Little Collins-street.

St. Kilda-road.—East side only-

North from Domain-road, north from Toorak-road, north from Armadale-street, north from Commercial-road, north from Moubraystreet, north from High-street.

South from City-road.

Pending the fixing of other stopping places, motor omnibuses shall only stop for the purpose of taking up and setting down passengers at such points upon the route as may be convenient, and in such manner as not to interfere with or endanger the general traffic of the streets or roads or the safety of passengers in the motor omnibuses.

Time-tables to be Observed.

At intervals of not more than ten minutes:—7 a.m. to 11.30 p.m. week days; 1 \tilde{p} .m. to 10.30 p.m. Sundays.

Fares to be Charged.

Maximum through fare, 5d.

The fares to be charged for children under twelve years of age (other than children under four years of age carried on passenger's lap, who shall be carried free) shall be one half of the fares charged for adult passengers, calculated to the nearest higher penny.

Maximum Number of Motor Omnibuses to be Used on Route. Eight.

H IS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the powers, conferred by section 3 of the Motor Omnibus Act 1924 (No. 3378), doth by this Order prescribe the routes within the metropolitan area along which motor omnibuses for which "regular service" licences are granted under the provisions of the Motor Omnibus Act may ply for hire, also sections and terminal points and stopping places on such routes, time-tables to be observed by owners of motor omnibuses plying for hire, fares to be charged, and the maximum number of motor omnibuses which may be licensed to ply for hire on any prescribed route, as set forth in detail in the Schedule hereunder:—

Fares to be Charged.

The farcs to be charged for children under 12 years of age (other than children under four years of age carried on passenger's lap, who hall be carried free) shall be one half of the farcs charged for adult passengers, calculated to the nearest higher penny.

Maximum Unladen Weight of Motor Omnibuses plying for hire on routes no part of which is within three miles of the Town Hall in the City of Melbourne.

His Excellency doth by this Order further provide that on a prescribed route, no part of which is within three miles of the Town Hall, in the City of Molbourne, the maximum unladen weight of any motor omnibus shall not exceed two and one-half tons if the motor omnibus is fitted with any tires other than pneumatic tires, and three and one-half tons if the motor omnibus is fitted with no tires other than pneumatic tires, without the consent of the licensing authority.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 11 (1) (c) of the Motor Omnibus Act 1924, the Governor in Council by this Order confers upon the licensing authority full power and authority for carrying into effect by the said licensing authority all of the foregoing provisions of this Order.

And the Honorable George Louis Goudie, His Majesty's Commissioner of Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
