All empty Containers and Packages that have been charged for will, where practicable, be returned to the Contractor, and if in good order and condition, the charge for same will be refunded by the Contractor. The rates to be allowed for such are set out in the appendix to the Schedule.

Each Container or Package for which a charge has been made must bear a label setting forth the price charged for same, and such labels must not be removed by departments from the articles returned.

In cases where special manufactures are mentioned in the schedule, the contractor will be bound to supply the goods in the original packages, having thereon the maker's label or other trade mark, as a guarantee of the genuineness of the goods so supplied.

All articles must be of the best quality of the several kinds, and all preparations and compounds are to be those of the new "British Pharmacopœia," unless otherwise specially ordered.
