Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PLASTERERS BOARD.

Norm.—This Determination on the 15th March, 1926, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons (other than labourers) wheresoever employed in the process, trade, or business of a plasterer," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 15th March, 1926, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but it any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted
