Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE TRAMWAY CONVERSION BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 17th March, 1926, applied to the Metropolitan District as Defined in the Factories and Shops Acts.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the occupation of Converting Cable Tramway Lines to Electric Traction, but not including persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Carters and Drivers Board," has made the following Determination, namely:—

- (1) That this Determination shall come into force on the 17th March, 1926.

(3) OVERTIME.—All work done in any week in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for at the Rate of Time and a Half.

(4) SPECIAL RATES.—Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
