Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE FURNITURE (BEDUING) BOARD.

Norg.-This Determination on the 6th January, 1923, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to any person employed in the manufacture of mattresses or bedding" has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 6th January, 1928, the last previous Determination shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
