## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the twenty-second day of May, 1928:  
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the nineteenth day of June, 1928.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eighteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and in the nineteenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
