NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ENFORCE COMPLIANCE.

WHEREAS Maryborough District Cool Stores and Ice Works Company Limited, a company registered under the provisions of Part One of the *Companies Act 1915*, and having its registered office at Maryborough, in the State of Victoria (hereinafter called "the Corporation") has made default in payment of principal and interest moneys due and payable by the Corporation under and by virtue of the Indentures of Agreement dated the fourth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, and made between the Corporation of the one part and His Majesty the King of the other part: And whereas the said agreement was entered into to secure the repayment of moneys advanced to the Corporation by way of loan under the provisions of the *Fruit Acts*, together with interest on such moneys, on the days and in the manner set forth in such agreement: Now therefore the Honorable Edmond John Hogan, the Treasurer of the said State, doth hereby give notice, in accordance with section twelve, sub-section five (a) of the *Fruit Act 1917*, of his intention to enforce compliance with the provisions of Part One of such Act.
