RAILWAYS CLASSIFICATION BOARD.

ORDERS OF 4TH JUNE, 1931, RELATING TO—

CERTAIN MATTERS ARISING OUT OF AWARDS NOS. 8, 20, AND 26 OF THE RAILWAYS CLASSIFICATION BOARD.

In the matter of the *Railways Act 1928* (No. 3759) and in the matter of references by the Victorian Division of the Australian Federated Union of Locomotive Enginemen for interpretations of certain matters arising out of Awards (Nos. 8, 20, and 26) of the Railways Classification Board.

THESE references having come on for hearing before the Railways Classification Board, and the said Board having heard the representations made on behalf of the parties concerned, it is ordered that the matters referred to be, and the same are hereby, interpreted as follows:—

AWARD No. 8.

Division 10.—*Holiday Duty.*

Engine-driver J. McLean is not entitled under the provisions of this Division to an extra day's pay or a day's leave on full pay in respect of the period occupied by him in travelling from Dandenong to Korumburra, and in signing off at the latter location, on New Year's Day (1st January, 1931).

Division 13.—*Relieving Expenses.*

Division 14.—*Travelling and Incidental Expenses.*

The provisions of Clause 8 of Division 13 and of Clause 6 of Division 14 are not applicable in the case of Engine-cleaner J. A. Tooley during the period he was at Woodend, viz., from 7th October, 1930, to 6th November, 1930.

Division 19.—*Relieving in Higher Positions.*

(a) The provisions of this Division are applicable in the case of an Engine-cleaner when acting as a Fireman, and also in the case of a Fireman when acting as an Engine-driver.

(b) The period of twelve (12) calendar months prescribed in Sub-clause (b) of Clause 3 of this Division must be served (either continuously or non-continuously) within the preceding period of two years before any officer or employee performing the duties of a position higher than that in which he is classified becomes entitled to payment of the equivalent of the next sub-divisional rate (if any) of salary or wage prescribed for such higher position. (*Vide* Orders of the Board dated 2nd December, 1927, and 17th December, 1928.)

AWARD No. 20.

Salaries and Wages for the Year 1926—*Rolling-stock Branch—Adult Male Employees.*

In the case of an Engine-driver in charge of one or more engines and crews at a location, the number of engines and crews rostered for the day's work at such location shall determine the rate of wage to which such Engine-driver in charge is entitled.

AWARD No. 26.

Salaries and Wages for the Year 1930.

The emergency deduction provided in Clause 5 is applicable in respect of the payment, viz., 1s. per day in addition to the ordinary wage, prescribed for an Engine-driver when driving country passenger or express trains.

Stopping Places on Route.

Pending the fixing of stopping places, motor omnibuses shall only stop for the purpose of taking up and setting down passengers at such points upon the route as may be convenient, and in such manner as not to interfere with or endanger the general traffic of the streets or roads or the safety of passengers in motor omnibuses.

Fares to be Charged.

The fares to be charged for children under twelve years of age (other than children under three years of age carried on passenger's lap, who shall be carried free) shall be one-half of the fares charged for adult passengers, calculated to the nearest higher penny.

His Excellency, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 5 (1) of the *Motor Omnibus Act 1928* (No. 3742), doth by this Order prescribe Route No. 76A a Developmental Route.

His Excellency doth by this Order further provide, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 15 (1) (b) of the *Motor Omnibus Act 1928* (No. 3742) that the Orders in Council approved by His Excellency the Governor in Council on the 24th December, 1930, and the 4th February, 1931, prescribing routes within the metropolitan area along which motor omnibuses for which "regular service" licences are granted under the provisions of the said Act may ply for hire, shall be amended in the manner following:—

Under the heading "Time tables to be observed" for the words and figures "Minimum service, 30 minutes between North Brighton Railway Station and McKinnon Railway Station and 60 minutes between North Brighton Railway Station and St. Kilda-street 8 a.m. to 11 p.m., week days, 2 p.m. to 11 p.m., Sundays," there shall be substituted the words and figures "Minimum service, 30 minutes—7.45 a.m. to 11 p.m., week days, 1.30 p.m. to 11 p.m., Sundays."
