# DETERMINATION OF THE COUNTRY PRINTERS BOARD.

Nozz.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State outside and excepting the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677) and the Order in Council thereunder, and such portion of the City of Sandringham as is not included within the said District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the towns of Mildura, and Newtown and Chiwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677) the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may, be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons (other than persons subject to the Determinations of the Printers Board or the Provincial Printers Board) employed in the process, trade, or business of—

- (a) Printing;
  (b) Bookbinding (including making loose sheet covers of any kind);

- (d) Stereotyping or electrotyping;
  (d) Stereotyping or electrotyping;
  (e) Preparing printed matter for sale or distribution;
  (f) Carbonising,
  Gumming,

  Gumm Gumming,
  Varnishing, or
  Paper, cardboard, or similar materials;
  Waxing

but not including any process subject to the jurisdiction of the Stationery Board," has made the following Determination, namely:—
