ELECTION OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA.

**H**IS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, has, by an Order made on the 27th day of November, 1931, in accordance with the provisions of section 3 of the *Senate Elections (Times and Places) Act 1928 (No. 3769)*, fixed the following dates for the holding of election of Senators of the Parliament of the Commonwealth for the State of Victoria, viz. :—
