## DETERMINATION OF THE FARRIERS BOARD.

Norm.—This Determination on 4th day of March, 1931, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan district as defined in the Factories and Shops Act and such portion of the City of Sandringham as is not included within the said District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any purson or persons, or classes of persons, employed in the process, trade, or business of a farrier," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 4th day of March, 1931, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(5) SPECIAL RATES.—Troble time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sundays, and on 26th January (Foundation Day), Good Friday, Easter Monday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), 3rd June (King's Birthday), Royal Agricultural Show Day (in localities mentioned in the Twelfth Schedule to the Public Service Act 1928), Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and New Year's Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

(6) DAY AND LATEST HOURS FOR PAYMENT OF WAGES.—The day and latest hour when payment of wages is to be made shall be Friday at 4.30 p.m.

(7) Time Wades.—Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall for each hour worked up to 22 hours be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of forty-two per centum.
