## DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 9 (DRAPERS AND MEN'S CLOTHING).

Norg. -1. On the 9th March, 1921, this Board was appointed in lieu of the Drapers Board and the Men's Clothing Board. 2. This Determination on the 11th day of May, 1931, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), and the order in Council thereunder; such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not included within the said Metropolitan District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

In a soordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the business of a seller of—

(a) any article of men's or boys' clothing, mercery, or wearing apparel, including underclothing, hats, and caps;
 (b) goods usually sold by drapers or haberdashors, including mantles, costumes, millinery, gloves, stockings, and underclothing,"

has made the following Determination, namely:-

(1) That on the 11th day of May, 1931, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination. (2)

(5) Time Rate.

Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall for each hour worked up to 24 hours be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of fifty per centum.

(6) MEAL INTERVAL. Each employee shall be allowed at least forty-five minutes for a meal on the evening of the local late trading day.

(7) Special Rates.

Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, and time and a half shall be the special rate for all work done on New Year's Day, Foundation Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day, King's Bithday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, or after 12.30 p.m. on Show Day (in localities mentioned in Royal Agricultural Show Act); but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
