VICTORIAN RAILWAYS.

STATE COAL MINE INDUSTRIAL TRIBUNAL.

AWARD No. 1 OF 23RD AUGUST, 1932, RELATING TO RATES OF PAY.

THE State Coal Mine Industrial Tribunal, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by the provisions of the *State Coal Mine Industrial Tribunal Act 1932* (No. 4030), and constituted as provided by the said Act and the Order in Council made thereunder dated 19th July, 1932, hereby determines and awards as follows (that is to say):—

1. The existing rate of wage, including contract rates, paid to employees mentioned in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Act shall be reduced by 20 per cent.
2. The existing rate of wage paid to employees mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Act, except Bricklayer, Carpenter, Carpenter (Leading Hand), Painter, and Plumber, shall be reduced by 20 per cent.
3. The existing rate of wage paid to employees mentioned in Part 3 of the Schedule to the Act, except Clerk, shall be reduced by 20 per cent.

This Award shall not apply to any worker engaged at the Montague Coal Depot.
