Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677).

DETERMINATION OF THE WHARFS AND JETTIES BOARD.

Note—This Determination, on the 2nd January. 1933, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677) and the Order in Conneil thereunder; such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not within the said District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warmambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol; and the Moorpanyal riding of the shire of Corio.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board which since the 10th November, 1927, has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of constructing or demolishing wooden or concrete wharfs, piers, or jetties," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 2nd January, 1933, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

⁽⁵⁾ SPECIAL RATES.—Double time shall be the rate payable for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, 26th January (Australia Day), Good Friday, Easter Monday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), 3rd June (King's Birthday), Christmas Day, or Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall be payable only for work done on the day so substituted.
